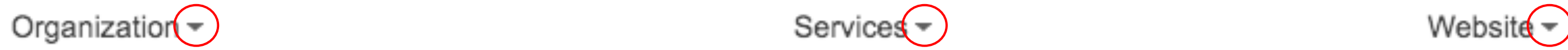



DATABASE SEARCH INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Use the arrows to pull up the search boxes:

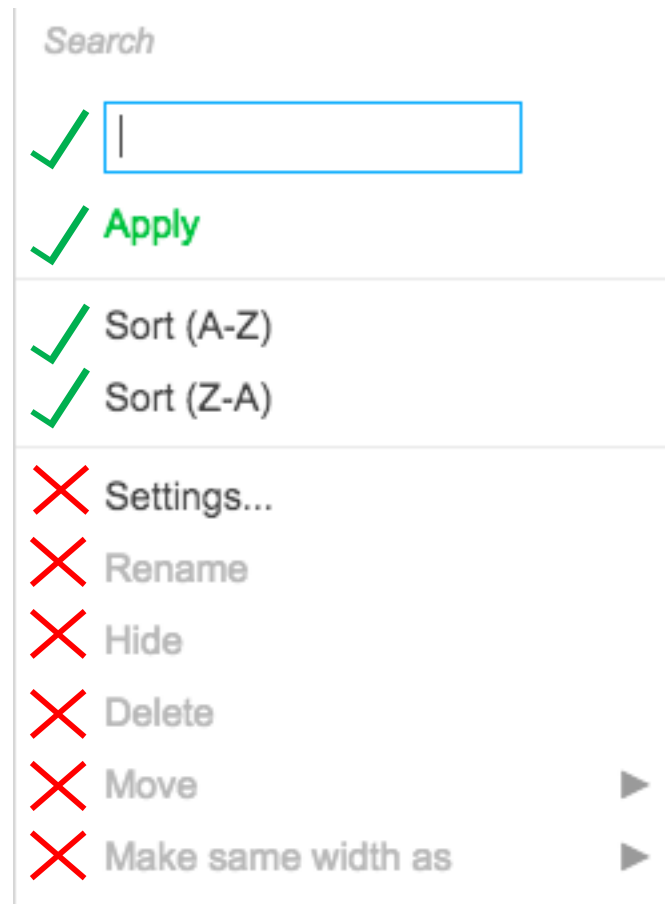


2. Enter your search terms. In this example, we searched for organizations with the word "Alaska" in the title who provide SLP services in Anchorage. You do not need to enter a search item in each box. You can also sort sections by name (A-Z or Z-A):
